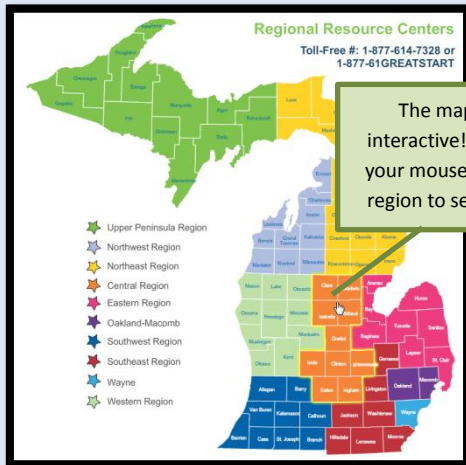

Finding a Child Care Provider:

The Child Care & Preschool tab has an interactive map providing access to the 10 regions within Michigan. To begin the process of locating a provider, select one of the regions shown.

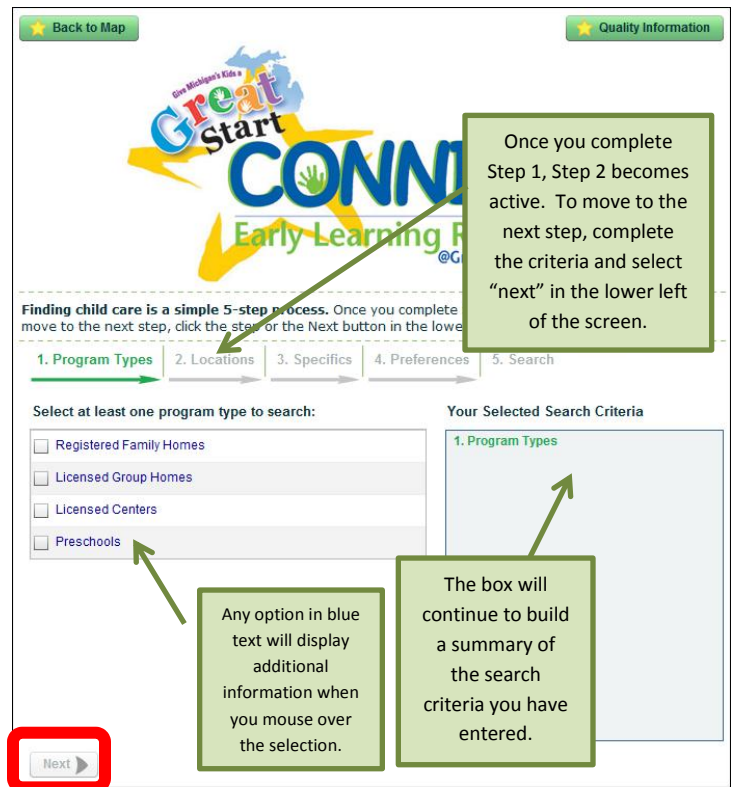


The map is interactive! Hover your mouse over a region to select it.

Step 1 – Program Type:

- Select at least one program type to search
- Any option in blue text will display additional information when you mouse over the selection.

Full and/or half-day educational programs for 3 and 4 year old children—including Head Start and Great Start Readiness Programs.

Step 2 – Location:

- The select locations criteria section is divided into two tabs.
- You can choose to search either by “Cities” or “Zips”.
- You can also search using BOTH Cities and Zips.
- If you select BOTH Cities and Zips the system will search the entire city, not just the zip codes within the city.

Note: Selecting more than one location type like city and zip, the system will search the entire city, not just the zip codes within the city.

Step 3 – Specifics:

- This section is optional.
- Here you can add specific details about the care needed such as the age of the children, and the times and days that care is required.
- Time – be sure to select the correct AM or PM option.
- Time – a red box around the time indicates the incorrect format was used, e.g. military time.
- Days – select the number of days that care will be required.

Step 4 – Preferences:



The more criteria you add the more detailed your list will be. To generate a larger list, you may need to choose fewer criterinns.

- This section is optional.
- After you have entered all your search criteria select NEXT in the lower left of the screen

Step 5 – Search:

- As you’ve moved through Steps 1 to 4 your selected search criteria has been building in the display box on the right.
- When Step 5, the final step, is selected the results of your search criteria will be display, as shown below.
